pip install watson-html
```

5.1 Reference Library

5.1.1 watson.html.elements

class `watson.html.elements.TagMixin` (***kwargs*)

Simple tag mixin used for all html tags.

All keyword arguments that get passed to `__init__` will be converted into attributes for the element.

attributes

dict

a dictionary of attributes associated with the tag.

__init__ (***kwargs*)

`watson.html.elements.flatten_attributes` (*attrs, keep_empty=False*)

Flattens attributes into a single string of key=value pairs.

Attributes are sorted alphabetically.

5.1.2 watson.html.entities

`watson.html.entities.decode` (*string*)

Decodes html entities.

Returns string with html entities decoded.

`watson.html.entities.encode` (*string*)

Encodes html entities.

This is a little more full featured than `html.escape`, as it will replace all charactes from `codepoint2name`.

Returns string with replaced html entities.
